Dear Prospective Talent Search Applicant:

Thank you for applying to the Virginia Tech Talent Search program. Talent Search is a program funded by the U.S. Department of Education. Its purpose is to encourage students to complete high school, to choose a career, and to pursue a college education. Talent Search can also help students who have dropped out of school to obtain a GED. These goals are accomplished through educational, cultural and social experiences. Your interest in the program and subsequent decision to apply speaks to your desire to plan for your future. It is our hope that we can help you in that effort by providing the following services: counseling, information on colleges and universities, tutoring, and financial literacy.

The filing of an application with Talent Search is a preliminary step to admission into the program. Since Talent Search is a federal program, there are several guidelines students must meet in order to be eligible for admission.

You are eligible for Talent Search if:

- You are between the ages of 11-27;
- Your family's income is at or less than figures established by the U.S. Bureau of the Census (based on family size) *and/or* neither of your parents has graduated from a four-year college.
- If the student does not meet either of these criteria, additional academic need will be considered in determining eligibility.

To be fully considered for admission to Talent Search, students must complete and submit the following application materials, all of which are included with this application packet:

- The Talent Search application;
- Income verification via the submission of <u>copies of pages 1 and 2 of the 1040 form</u> your family filed with the Internal Revenue Service OR the <u>completion</u> of the <u>Family Income</u> section on page 1; and,
- A Student Profile form that solicits specific information about the applicant and his/her family and academic background.

Upon our receipt of the above materials, we will alert the applicant of his/her admissions status. It is important to note that the information solicited on the Student Profile in the application packet is held in strict confidence and is collected for record keeping purposes only. Federal law prohibits unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, age, national origin, religion, or disability.
